- Driving under the influence of marijuana endangers you and everyone else on the road.
- It's illegal for a reason.



- Using marijuana while pregnant can cause physical and mental health consequences to the baby that might not show up till later.
- It's not safe to use to relieve nausea.



- Marijuana smoke contains many of the same cancer causing toxins as cigarettes, and second hand smoke harms the health of those who breathe it in.
- It's especially harmful to kids, and those with asthma, lung or heart issues.
